
DURATION

MATERIALS

15-20 minutes

- Blender
- 2–3 strawberries
- Strainer, sieve, or spoon
- 1 cup water

PROCEDURE



Combine strawberries and water in the blender.



Blend the strawberries and water until there are no solid chunks left. Wait 10 seconds for the strawberry seeds to float to the top.



Use a strainer, sieve, or spoon to remove the seeds.



Plant the seeds in a pot of dirt or outside in your garden.



Every day, check on your strawberry seeds and watch them grow!
